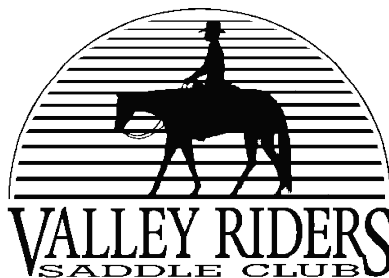

NOVICE RIDER ENG/WEST PLEASURE, NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP: Rider never placing 1st in a class of 3 or more 4 times in the last 5 years in a class of this type in any Breed, 4-H or Open Show. **No Payback.

**** JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL ****

AQHA Rules Will Apply - Appropriate Attire Required

***SCHOOLING CLASS: Safe attire = long pants, boots with heel, and appropriate headgear. **This class is not judged and has no payback.** Year end awards are not given in schooling classes.

++ Exhibitors who are 50 & over may show in the 50 & over class OR the corresponding 19 & over class but not both classes of the same type. Eligibility based on horse/exhibitor combination.

Exhibitors who are 9 & under may show in Small Fry OR 13 & under classes. If they ride in ANY Small Fry classes, they must ride ONLY in Small Fry riding classes. Small Fry exhibitors may also show in Halter and Nov Showmanship classes.

DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH NO LONGER THAN 6 FT.
