Lead Line Class

6 & under. May not show in any other riding class.

Walk/Trot Classes

Horse/rider combination entered in a Level 1 Walk/Trot class may not show in the corresponding lope/canter class.

Bedding

Bedding will only be available if preordered and paid for with stall reservations.

Stalls

Stalls must be reserved with payment. See valleyriders.com for the form. *Due to the limited number of stalls available, we request that you do not reserve tack stalls. We need every stall available for horses.* Refunds will be made if requested by 5/10/18. After 5/10/18, refunds will only be given if we are able to fill the stall. Jackpot Classes
