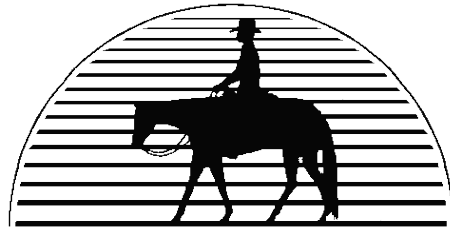

\$120 package includes all AQHA class entry fees for one horse, AQHA/IQHA fee, AQHA drug fee. Includes unlimited classes in unlimited divisions with unlimited riders for one horse including Small Fry. Crossovers from Rookie, Level 1, Youth, Amateur, and Open are encouraged. Does not include office fee, stall/jump out fee, bedding, electric/camping, or Jackpot classes.

Jackpot Classes per Judge – 80% Payback	\$12

Small Fry Classes

9 & under walk/trot. May not show in any class requiring a lope or canter.

Lead Line Class

6 & under. May not show in any other riding class.

Walk/Trot Classes

Horse/rider combination entered in a Level 1 Walk/Trot class may not show in the corresponding lope/canter class.

Bedding

Bedding will only be available if preordered and paid for with stall reservations.

Stalls

Stalls must be reserved with payment. See valleyriders.com for the form. ***Due to the limited number of stalls available, we request that you do not reserve tack stalls. We need every stall available for horses.*** Refunds will be made if requested by 5/8/20. After 5/8/20, refunds will only be given if we are able to fill the stall. Stall reservation form on valleyriders.com.

++ Concurrent Classes

Rookie and Level 1 pattern classes marked ++ will be run concurrently. Exhibitors may enter either class or both classes as long as they are eligible for that level.

Jackpot Classes

Jackpot classes are not AQHA approved and are open to all. They must be entered at least 2 classes prior to the start of the class. No gate entries will be admitted to these classes. 80% payback will be distributed 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%.
