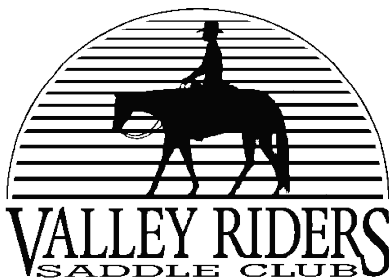

Exhibitors are required to provide registration papers for any class upon request.

NOVICE RIDER ENG/WEST PLEASURE, NOVICE SHOWMANSHIP: Exhibitor never placing 1st in a class of 3 or more 4 times in the last 5 years in a class of this type in any Breed, 4-H or Open Show. **No Payback.

^^ **LEADLINE** - Exhibitors age 6 & under may show in Leadline OR Small Fry. If they show in Leadline, they may show in Leadline classes and Halter classes only. In any class, there must be an adult handler holding a lead attached to the horse. Handler must be able to control the animal at all times.

**** JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL ****

AQHA rules will apply unless superseded by Valley Riders rules
Appropriate Attire Required

***SCHOOLING CLASS: Safe attire = long pants, boots with heel, and appropriate headgear. **This class is not judged and has no payback.** Year end awards are not given in schooling classes.

++ **SELECT** - Exhibitors who are 50 & over may show in the 50 & over class OR the corresponding 19 & over class but not both classes of the same type. Eligibility based on horse/exhibitor combination.

SMALL FRY - Exhibitors who are 9 & under may show in Small Fry OR 13 & under classes. If they ride in ANY Small Fry classes, they must ride ONLY in Small Fry riding classes. Small Fry exhibitors may also show in Halter and Nov Showmanship classes.

- We reserve the right to combine classes of 3 or less.
- A horse may not be shown more than once per class.
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH NO LONGER THAN 6 FT.**
